



COURTESY BUS SERVICE

TERMS AND CONDITION OF CARRIAGE

1. The courtesy bus service is provided by the club for members, their guests and visitors of the club, and is not a public transport service. People using the bus must patronize the club.
2. Persons under the age of 18 are not to travel on the courtesy bus unless accompanied by an adult. Due to RMS laws, children under 8 years of age are not permitted to travel on the bus.
3. No smoking or consumption of food or alcohol on the bus.
4. The driver has the right to ask anyone to leave the bus for bad behavior, offensive language or not adhering to the courtesy bus rules, or reasonable directions from the driver.
5. The driver has the discretion to decide the order of drop-off and pick-up and this is not to be disputed.
6. Do not ask the driver to take a patron to another hospitality venue or business. The Transport Act only permits courtesy bus services to collect and drop off to a person's residence.
7. The driver can at all times request the name and address of a patron when boarding the bus.
8. Patrons are requested to be considerate to the driver and all other patrons on board the bus.
9. Club dress and behaviour standards apply to the courtesy bus.
10. The club reserves the right to change this free service at any time.
11. Seatbelts must be worn by everyone once the bus is moving.
12. Bookings – to come to the club, reserve your seat by calling 02 4966 3361. You must provide your name, address, how many passengers, the time you wish to be picked up, and a contact number.
13. Bookings – to travel home from the club, please give your name at the club's reception (please make your way to the front entrance 5 minutes prior to the expected departure time).
14. The bus will operate Thursday through to Sunday evenings at the specified times. The club reserves the right to change the schedule at any time.
15. The club will make every effort to pick up at your residence at your preferred booking time, however, due to the volume of bookings at certain times, no guarantees can be made.
